



Verapol Chandeying M.D. is Professor of Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, School of Medicine, University of Phayao. He has authored or co-authored about 45 scientific publications in the field of STDs, HIV and Sexual Health, as well as a book of Sexually Transmitted Infections and HIV - An illustrated guide to management (2009).

He currently is Dean of School of Medicine, University of Phayao in a province of Northern Thailand. In the past, he was Director of Studies of the Consortium of Thai Training Institutes for STD and AIDS (COTTISA), and Vice President of the Thai Medical Society for the Study of Sexually Transmitted Diseases (TMS-STD), and had initiated and annually conducted the International STDs/AIDS Diploma Course since 1991 until 2011 for medical and paramedical personnel. As yet, more than 374 alumni, mostly in Asia, were graduated.

He also involved in executive position of the international academic bodies such as Regional Director (Asia Pacific region) of International Union against of Sexually Transmitted Infections - IUSTI (1999 to 2007), Board of Director of International Society of Sexually Transmitted Diseases Research – ISSTD (2001 to 2007), and President of Asia Oceania Federation for Sexology – AOFS (2006 to 2008).
